LAW NO. 1 (2021)

A Law to appropriate out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund to the services of the Government of Cross River State of Nigeria for the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2021, the sum of Fifty-Two Billion, Six Hundred and Sixty-Six Million, Eight Hundred and Fifteen Thousand, Two Hundred and Sixteen Naira, aforesaid, to authorize out of the Capital Development Fund, the sum of Two Hundred and Four Billion, One Hundred and Forty-Four Million, One Hundred and Fifty-Four Thousand, Four Hundred and Six Naira

Commencement

The Cross River State House of Assembly enacts as follows –

Enactment

1. The Accountant-General of Cross River State of Nigeria may, when authorized so to do by Warrants issued by the Governor pay out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the State during the year ending on the 31st day of December, 2021 the sums specified by the Warrants, not exceeding in the aggregate Fifty-Two Billion, Six Hundred and Sixty-Six Million, Eight Hundred and Fifteen Thousand, Two Hundred and Sixteen Naira being the total of the amount set out opposite the Heads of Expenditure in Schedule 1 and may for the like period and in like manner pay out of the Capital Development Fund the sums specified by Warrants not exceeding in the aggregate Two Hundred and Four Billion, One Hundred and Forty-Four Million, One Hundred and Fifty-Four Thousand, Four Hundred and Six Naira being the total of the amounts set out opposite the Heads of Expenditure in Schedule 2.

2. The said sums, not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty-Six Billion, Eight Hundred and Ten Million, Nine Hundred and Sixty-Nine Thousand, Six Hundred and Twenty-Two Naira, shall be appropriated for the purpose and in the manner expressed in the relevant Schedules

3. The said sum does not include Statutory Votes of Twenty-Five Billion, One Hundred and Twenty-Nine Million, Nine Hundred and Ten Thousand, Six Hundred and Eight Naira, being the Votes so extracted from the Heads of Expenditure set out in Schedule 3 hereto.

4. No part of the amount mentioned in Section 2 of this Law shall be issued out of the respective funds after the 31st day of December, 2021.

Prohibition of issue after
31st December, 2021.

5. (1) The power to issue Warrants for the purpose of this Law shall be deemed to have been delegated by the State Governor to the Commissioner for Finance.


Delegation of issue of
Warrants.

(2) Notwithstanding the delegation under sub-section (1) of this Section, the State Governor may himself exercise the power to issue Warrants under this Law.

6. This Law may be cited as the Cross River State Appropriation Law 2021, and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 2021.


